# SCAVENGER HUNT

## SET UP

1. Attach the hanging placards to the ceiling around the party space (for example, in different rooms of the house). Make the scavenger hunt as challenging as desired, but it is suggested to keep the hanging placards visible.
2. Give each player an answer sheet.
3. Have the players line up at a starting place.

## OBJECT

Discover which of the nine pictures on your answer sheet does not have a sticker to pair with!

## HOW TO PLAY

1. On the count of 1-2-3 players will scatter throughout the party space looking for the hanging placards. **Note:** Encourage everyone to go their own direction instead of moving as a group.
2. When a player finds a hanging placard, they will:
  - Look at the pictures on both sides of the hanging placard.
  - Remove the sticker on the back of the answer sheet that matches one side of the hanging placard.
  - Place it next to the picture on the front that matches the other side of the hanging placard.
3. When all 8 stickers have been moved to the front of the answer sheet, a player has completed the hunt. **Note:** There will be one picture without a sticker. It is a secret! Confirm that this picture does not have a corresponding sticker to quickly check all the player's answer sheets. (The picture without a sticker is indicated below.)
4. The first player to return to the starting area with a correctly completed answer sheet wins!

### PLAYING WITH MULTIPLE GAMES

If you have more than one **Scavenger Hunt** game and more than 8 players, you may use all the hanging placards for a large party space or just use 8 for a smaller party space.
